1	Sanctuary of Flora and Fauna of Iguaque: An ecological long hike from the high-Andean jungle to the moor (Páramo), where you can see the diversity of the flora and fauna. This leads to the sacred lake of Iguaque (3.600 m) the origin of the Muisca mythology. It is also one of the best places to practice bird watching. <i>Surcharge for the biologist (ornithologist, entomologist, botanist)</i> <i>Entrance: Local: \$13.000.
